City of Gainesville Solid Waste Division Expands Fleet

Gainesville, TX– The City of Gainesville is adding a new truck to the Solid Waste Division of the General Services Department. This enhancement to our fleet is a key step towards continuing to increase the efficiency and speed of our waste collection routes, ensuring that all residents receive timely and reliable service.

While the scheduled pickup days will remain unchanged, the time our drivers arrive in the neighborhoods might vary due to the updated routing made possible by the additional truck.

Therefore, the introduction of this new truck means that residents must be extra mindful of the deadlines for placing their trash carts at the curb. To facilitate smooth and efficient operations, residents are reminded to have their carts at the street by 6:00 AM on the morning of their scheduled pickup day. Those in downtown and surrounding neighborhoods should have their carts out by 3:00 AM on their scheduled pickup day. All residents may put their cart on the curb as early as 6pm the night before for convenience.

“We are continually striving to improve our services, and this new truck is a significant step toward that goal,” said Polly Boone, General Services Director. “By placing carts out by 6 o’clock in the morning, residents will help us maintain the high standard of service that our community expects and deserves.”
