Gainesville, TX – The Gainesville Police Department remains committed to thoroughly review all available information to ensure a complete and just process for the case of Jocelyn Rojo Carranza.

At this time, there are no new statements to be made regarding the case. The Department appreciates the community’s patience and cooperation as it works diligently to gather all relevant facts.

“We understand the community’s desire for answers,” said Chief Kevin Phillips. “However, to maintain the integrity of the investigation, we are unable to release further details at this time. We assure the public that every aspect of this case is being carefully examined.”
